Who Can Go to Camp:

Sussex residents, 4-H club members, and students who are ages 9-13 as of January 1, 2017 (youth from surrounding counties are also welcome).

Camp Fees:

The total cost per youth is \$225. This fee covers overnight lodging, three nutritious meals per day, some snacks, counselor and adult supervision, enrichment classes, program costs, camp t-shirt, and transportation.

Registration Deadline:

Return the attached registration form and \$25 non-refundable deposit by June 16, 2017. This will reserve your youth a space at camp. There will be a \$50 fee on all returned checks.

Cancellations must be made on or before June 16, 2017.

There are limited partial scholarships available for qualified campers on a first-come basis. This application does not guarantee that your child will be awarded a scholarship. Scholarships are need-based and will be determined by the scholarship committee. Please call our office at (804) 834-1309 to request an application.
